

Tennis Policies

Guest Policy & Fees

Guest fee applies to registered family, friends and renters of Club Amenities members of Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club.

Residents of Wiggins Bay, Tarpon Cove and/or Tarpon Bay who do not have a Club Amenities Membership to Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club do not have privileges nor access to the Club's tennis courts and may not participate in any tennis club activities. Tennis Club activities include: tennis play, league/team play, tournaments, round robins and/or play as a guest of a club member.

Residents of Wiggins Bay, Tarpon Cove and Tarpon Bay who do not have a Club Amenities Membership to Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club may only have access to the Club's tennis courts when having a private, semi-private or clinic lesson as approved by the Director of Tennis.

Member rates apply to Club Amenities and Corporate Memberships at Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club who are in good standing only. All fees and charges are subject to change without notice.

Tennis Rules & Dress Code Policies

Please comply with the below Tennis Dress Code policies when playing at the Club:

- Shoes:
 1. Made-for-tennis clay court shoes only.
 2. No running shoes, cross-trainer sneakers, or deck shoes.
- Men:
 1. Collared sports shirts, non-collared tennis shirts, sleeveless "made for tennis" shirts for men and Tarpon Cove Logo T-shirts are permitted.
 2. T-Shirts, undershirts, tank tops or fishnet shirts are not permitted.
 3. Proper tennis shorts are permitted.
 4. Jeans, jean shorts, cargo shorts, cut-offs, bathing suits and shorts that require belts are not permitted.
- Ladies:
 1. Collared sports shirts, non-collared tennis shirts, sleeveless "made for tennis" shirts, and Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club T-shirts are permitted.
 2. T-shirts, undershirts, tank tops, sports bras or fishnet shirts are not permitted.
 3. All shirt worn must be long enough to cover mid-section.
 4. Made for tennis skirts, tennis dresses and tennis shorts are permitted.
 5. Jeans, jean shorts, cargo shorts, cut-offs, bathing suits and running shorts are not permitted.

Please comply with the below Tennis Rules when playing at the Club:

1. All players and guests must sign-in in the Tennis Pro Shop before play. Member and guests are expected to demonstrate good manners and good sportsmanship at all times.
2. All members & registered guests must carry their member cards with them at all times.
3. USTA rules of tennis etiquette apply at all times.

Tennis Guest Privileges

Please be advised of the following policies:

- Guest Privileges apply only to guests of registered members of Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club in good fiscal standing. Members who are not in good fiscal standing at the Club will have requests for Guest Privileges denied.
- Residents of Wiggins Bay, Tarpon Cove and/or Tarpon Bay who do not have a Club Amenities Membership to Tarpon Cove Yacht & Racquet Club are not permitted any Tennis Privileges

Family Guest Play

As a registered member of the Club, you may have family guests play tennis for a fee of \$15.00 per person, per day. Family guests can play a maximum of five (5) times during a calendar year.

Non-Family Guest Play

As a registered member of the Club, you may have non-family guests play tennis for a fee of \$15.00 per person, per day. Non-family guests can play a maximum of two (2) times during a calendar year.

Tenant/Rental Guest Play

If a registered member of the Club is renting their unit and allowing their renters to use their membership privileges, then the renters may play tennis as much as they choose during the rental period.

The Member must complete the appropriate paperwork at the Clubhouse and pay the rental transfer fee beforehand. With the paperwork and payment, the renter(s) will receive a Guest Card that indicates their privileges.

The renter(s) must show the Guest Card issued by the Club each time that they wish to play tennis.

If a registered member of the Club is renting their unit and allowing their renters to use their membership privileges, then the renters may play tennis as much as they choose during the rental period.

The Member must complete the appropriate paperwork at the Clubhouse and pay the rental transfer fee beforehand. With the paperwork and payment, the renter(s) will receive a Guest Card that indicates their privileges.

The renter(s) must show the Guest Card issued by the Club each time that they wish to play tennis.
